

Using Television Output on the AJP 7200

PREPERATION: What do you need for the installation?

AJP 7200 notebook with BIOS version 1.06 or newer. TV Output cable (supplied).
RCA to S-Video or RCA to SCART cable (not supplied).

Step 1: BIOS Settings

This procedure needs to be performed once and once only.

BIOS version R1.06 or newer is required. To check the BIOS version on your 7200, switch the machine on and look at the last part of the third line of text. This will contain the date and version number of the BIOS. If your BIOS is an earlier version than R1.06, please contact AJP technical support for a BIOS update.

You also need to switch TV Output on in the BIOS Setup. To do this, switch the computer off and then on. Upon startup the machine will run through a quick memory test and then display the message "**Hit Del if you want to run setup**". At this point, press the **Del** key. (If done too slowly, you will see the message "**WAIT...**" and the machine will boot as normal. In this case, switch it off and try again).

If done correctly you will end up in the **AMIBIOS Setup** program. Using the trackpad, double click the **Peripheral** icon. In the **Peripheral Setup** window, click **TV Mode** and set it to **PAL** if it is not already set. Press **Esc** until the **Exit Setup** window is displayed and then select **Save changes and Exit**.

Step 2: Setting up the 7200 and the output device

The following procedure needs to be performed each time the machine is used with a television. Connect TV output cable to 7200. Connect S-Video or SCART connector to television set. Connect these two cables together via the RCA connectors.

Switch on TV and set to an AV channel. Switch on 7200, start Windows 95 and load **Control Panel**. From **Control Panel** double click **Display** icon. Click the **Settings** tab in **Display Properties**. Use the **Desktop Area** slider bar to set the screen resolution to **640x480** pixels. Click OK to close the **Display Properties** window.

Hold down the **fn** key (on bottom left of keyboard) and tap the **F6** key (center of top row on keyboard) until a picture appears on the TV set.

Note

When in 640x480 resolution the screen display on the notebook may be either very small or blocky. To toggle between the two, hold down the **fn** key and tap the **F3** key. The display can be reset to 1024x768 in the Control Panel when TV output is no longer required.

TV screens are very low resolution. The picture quality on the television may be poor. We do not recommend using it for high resolution graphics or text such as word processing or spreadsheets.

AJP cannot provide technical support on your TV. If you are unsure as to what connectors your television possesses or how to set it to AV mode, consult the instruction manual for the television.

We hope the above information is sufficient to enable you to setup your 7200. Meanwhile if you have any problems do not hesitate to contact our Technical Support Department.
