

Installing Video Capture on the AJP 8500P computer.

PREPARATION: What do you need for the installation?

You will need the **Multimedia Notebook CD-ROM** that came with your notebook.

STEP 1: Setting the BIOS

You will only need to do this once. Once the settings have been changed, there is no need to do them again. To get into the BIOS, follow these steps. Start the computer up. As it is booting a message will appear saying

<CTRL-ALT-S> to enter System Configuration Utility. Press these three keys together to enter the BIOS. Once in the BIOS use the trackpad to click on the **Components** menu. Click on **Video In Mode**. Click on **Enabled**, then click **OK**. Video in is now enabled. To save the changes and exit the BIOS, Click on the **Exit** menu, then click on **Save and Exit**. Click on **OK**.

STEP 2: Installing the Video Capture Driver.

Once the computer has booted into your operating system (e.g. Windows 98), place the **Multimedia Notebook PC CD** in the CD ROM drive. Double click on the **My Computer** icon. Double click on the **CD Icon**, Double click on the **Videoin** Folder. Scroll down until you find the **Ati** icon with **Setup** written underneath. Double click on this icon. The Ati Setup will now begin. **Express Setup** should already be highlighted, if it is not, please highlight it. Then click **Finish**. Files will then be copied across. To Restart the computer for the changes to take effect click **Yes**. The computer will now restart. Plug in your video-capturing device. The Video in socket is situated on the back of the computer. It is an RCA jack Video input port. Once it is plugged in, click on the **Start** menu, **Programs**, **ATI Multimedia** and finally on **ATI Player**. This will launch the video capturing software. This software enables you to record and save to your harddrive in avi format.
